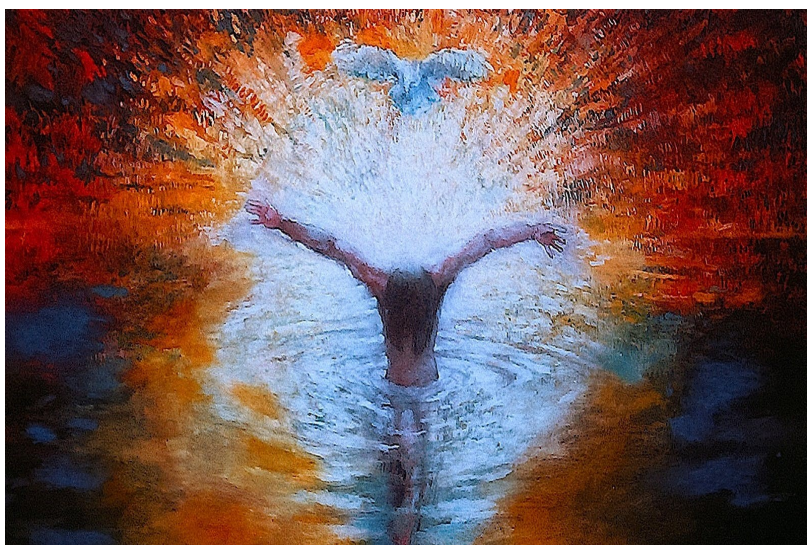

Meditation Prayer:

“At the very commencement of Jesus’ public ministry, all three of the divine Persons make their presence felt, and this tells us something of crucial significance, namely, that the one God of Israel, the God spoken of by every patriarch and prophet is a play of relations, a family. Another iconic display of the divine Persons at the Baptism of the Lord speaks another profound truth, one more soteriological than ontological. The Father has sent the Son on a mission to go all the way to the bottom of sin, all the way under the water of our dysfunction, in order to gather all of us into the life of the Spirit, the love shared by the Father and the Son. In short, both who God is and what God does for us are revealed in the Trinitarian manifestation on the banks of the Jordan.” - Bishop Robert Barron. Annotated.
