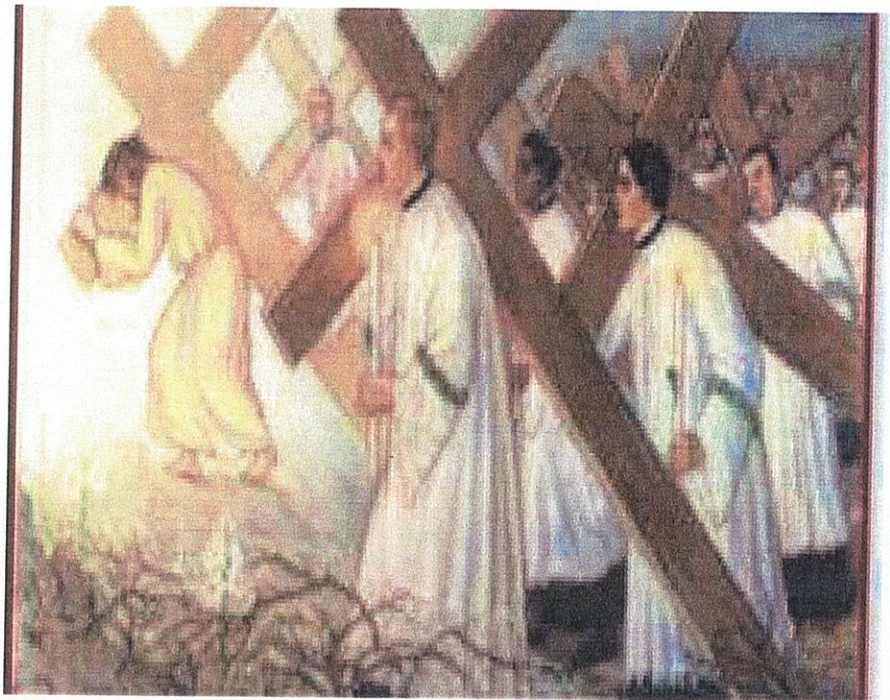

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Weighed down by financial woes, relationship stress, illnesses—all concerns of modern life—how can we concern ourselves with anything more than these immediate needs. Our “earthly” instincts limit our ability to think with an eternal perspective. God tells us that He has sent His Holy Spirit from on high to assist us> “And thus were the paths of those on earth made straight. “Relying on the Holy Spirit, we can live for higher goals despite all the challenges of daily life.

Second Reading: Christ shares two parables. One is a builder who wants to construct a tower. Before he begins: Christ tells him to consider the cost. Two is of a king facing a battle. Again: Christ says he must consider if there are sufficient troops. Discipleship will cost us and we must be prepared to give it our all.

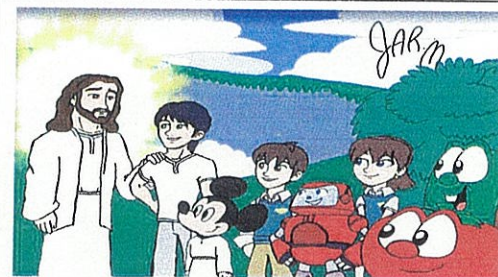

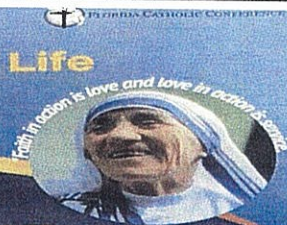
