Reflection on Sunday's readings:

<u>First reading:</u> "All things were created through him and for him. He is before all things and in him all things hold together...For in him all the fullness was pleased to dwell." This tells us our lives are not about us. They are about Christ -we will advance his kingdom. My life is not about me; it is about serving the King of kings.

<u>Second Reading</u>: What powerful lessons this King teaches us from the Cross. We learn that true leadership is displayed in emptying ourselves for others, that true greatness is displayed by way of humility, that none of us is worthy of the call to stewardship of His kingdom but that all of us, are welcomed and invited to take up his call. This will mean suffering and sacrifice. But the King promises that His faithful stewards will one day be with Him in Paradise!


