Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: The celebration of the birth of our Savior, and the anticipation of his second coming. These are weighty tasks with eternal consequences. The church's guidance to use these weeks as a time to focus on our spiritual lives can indeed seem like a mountain climb. We are to scale back on material gift giving, so that we have more time for spiritual preparations: Confession, weekday Mass, adoration, family prayer, lighting the Advent wreath and acts of kindness.

Second Reading: We must prepare for the celebration of our Savior's birth and the anticipation of His second coming. St. Paul in his letter to the Romans. "It is the hour now for you to awake from sleep" We must become like Christ. "Put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the desires of the flesh."
