Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: In our Gospel passage from Luke, Christ reminds us very clearly that we were made for more than just this life and that our choices have eternal consequences. The Lord tells us that there is resurrection. "Those who deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead...can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of God, because they are the ones who will rise.

<u>Second Reading</u>: Stewardship is not about the amount or kind of time, talent, and treasure we offer. It is that everything we have is a gift from our loving God, whom we can never truly repay and with whom we want to live forever. Revisit these 3 aspects of our lives regularly, prayerfully discerning the best use of our gifts, and putting it down in writing clarifies and strengthens our conviction to put God first.
