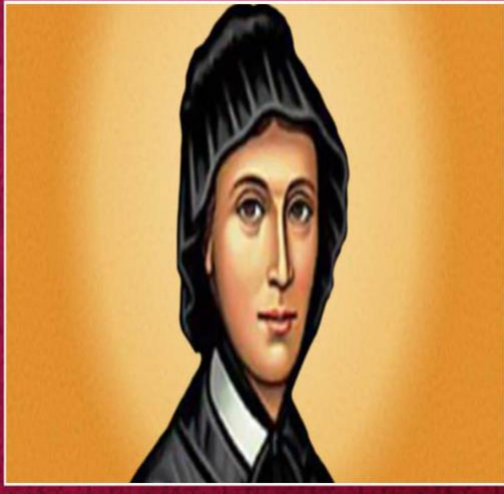

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: “ For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is the Messiah and Lord, and this will be a sign for you: you will find an infant wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger, and suddenly there was a multitude of the heavenly host with the angel, praising God and saying: ‘Glory to God in the Highest’.”

Second Reading: From the Letter to the Hebrews complements and affirms the feeling expressed in Isaiah. It is clear that Jesus is God and that today marks the beginning of salvation for us. The first word is “God” as that is where it all begins. John wants us to understand that Jesus came too us directly from God as He is One with God. He is the Word. John states of his Gospel: “Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.” Today is day of life and light. It is truly a day on which we must proclaim “ Glory to God in the highest.”
