

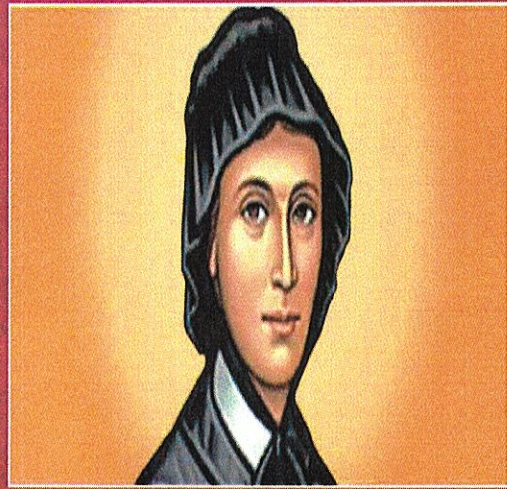

**Reflection on Sunday's readings:**

**First reading:** From Isaiah, we hear the voice of the “Suffering Servant” – prophetic words of Jesus Christ. “Now the Lord has spoken who formed me as his servant from the womb.” Even from the moment of his conception in the womb of our Blessed Mother, Jesus’ saving mission had begun.

**Second Reading:** St. Paul to the Corinthians, gives us a reminder of our true identity as God’s servants and the high calling we have as Christian stewards. “To you who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be holy...” We are called to nothing less than holiness. After all, only the holy can enter heaven. He truly does “rank ahead” of us; he deserves to be first, above all other priorities and plans in our lives. Does the way I spend my time reflect that God Comes first? Does prayer and weekly Mass and time with my family “rank ahead” of everything on my calendar? Do I use my talents, skills and energy to serve my family, parish and community in recognition of God’s kingdom?

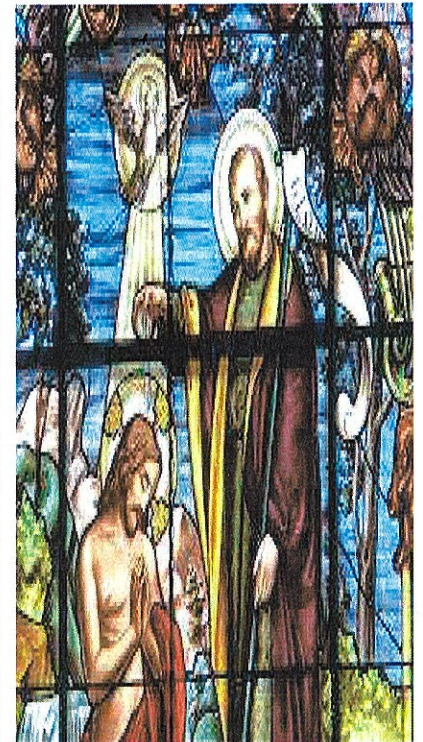
