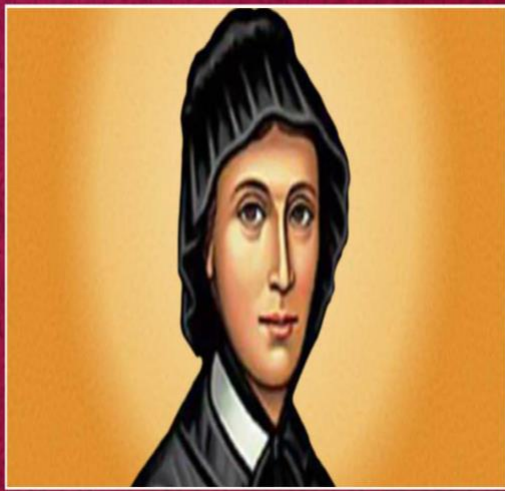

**Reflection on Sunday's readings:**

**First reading:** Today's readings remind us that stewardship is not just a thing we do—rather, stewardship is at the core of who we are as disciples of Christ. With this privilege comes the responsibility to actually live for God and to bring His Good News to all those we meet whether it be at work, school, in our community or right in our own home.

**Second Reading:** St. Paul urges us to keep sharing the Gospel our foremost priority, in the First Letter to the Corinthians. He urges Christians to “be united in the same mind and the same purpose,” reminding them that it was Christ and only Christ who was crucified for us. We owe everything to Him. Our lives are therefore not about us, our egos, our personal ambitions and loyalties. Those things do not satisfy us. Our loyalty must be to Christ above all else and our priority must be to bring his light to everyone He puts in our path. “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Turn away from selfishness, Now!
