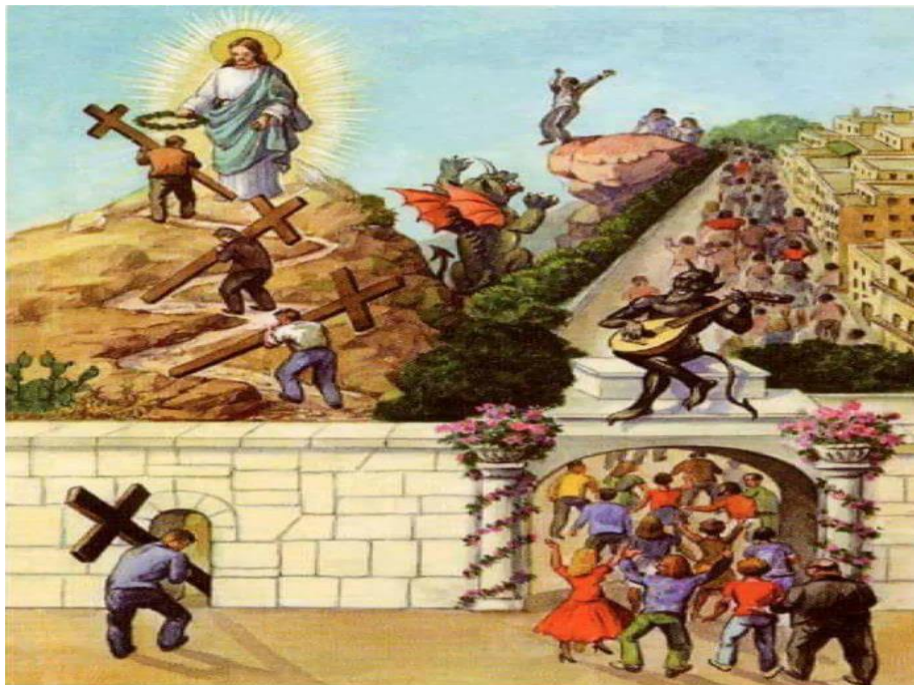

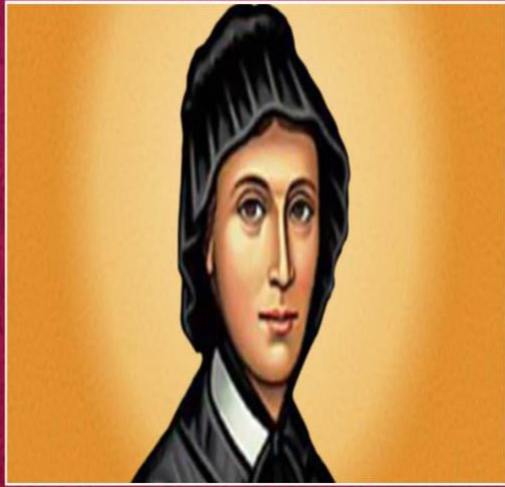

**Reflection on Sunday's readings:**

**First reading:** Today's readings remind us that it is not enough to be Christ's disciple, we must live for Christ every day and in every aspect of life. We must Seek the Lord. "This kind of life takes strength and discipline. We need spiritual disciplines to become ever more aware of God's constant provision for us and keep us on the narrow path towards the Kingdom of Heaven. "Blessed are the Poor in Spirit"

**Second Reading:** Jesus does not want us to merely go through the motions of faith. Jesus wants to know us deeply and us to know him and become his holy disciples. This is a privilege. But it takes discipline-the discipline of a stewardship way of life. Holiness of life, true discipleship, is meant for everyone, young, old, rich and poor, powerful and lowly. Jesus, our Light and Salvation is here. He brings with him cleansing and consoling and communing. You must choose him now—run to Him, He is here!
