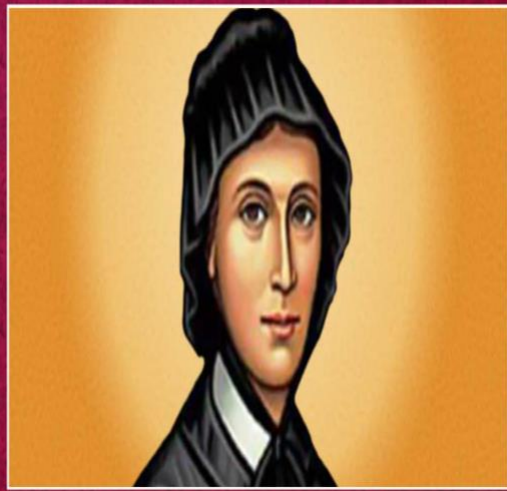

**Reflection on Sunday’s readings:**

**First reading:** In the Gospel, St. Matthew tells us, “Magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, “Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage.” These men represent the universal search for happiness, written by God on each human heart.

**Second Reading:** When the Magi reach the humble place where Jesus was born, they encounter a divine child. The Magi see God revealed in human flesh, Jesus, the Son of God who comes to fulfill the human longing for happiness. St. Matthew recounts, “They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and when they saw the child with Mary his mother, they prostrated themselves and bid him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold Frankincense, and myrrh.” Jesus is revealed as the universal light of the world to all peoples, not just a chosen few. As we renew our faith, let us approach him with joyful confidence and pray, “speak to me, Lord.”
