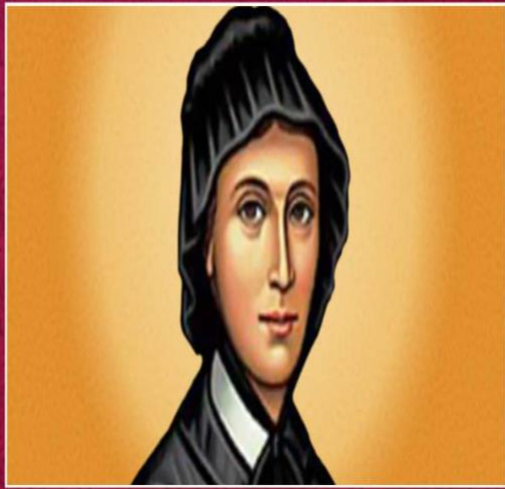

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: From the prophet Isaiah. "Thus says the Lord: Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless, clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own. " This is a "must do" for the Christian Steward. We must live our lives so that others see the things that we do, the way we serve others, care for the vulnerable, prioritize our family relationships and above all, our love for God-and then give Him Glory.

Second Reading: Our weakness is no obstacle for God – He uses our weaknesses to show His glory if we simply cooperate with Him. Jesus declares to us, His disciples, that we are the "salt of the earth" and the "light of the world." But, salt no longer has flavor if stale, light cannot bring its blessed brightness if left hidden. Therefore, we must live our lives so that others will see the things that we do, the ways we serve others, care for the vulnerable, prioritize our family relationships and our love for God –and then give Him glory.

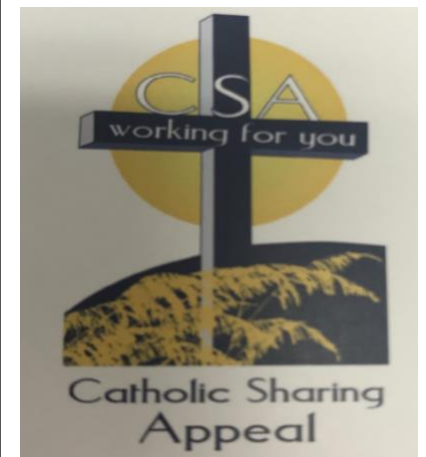

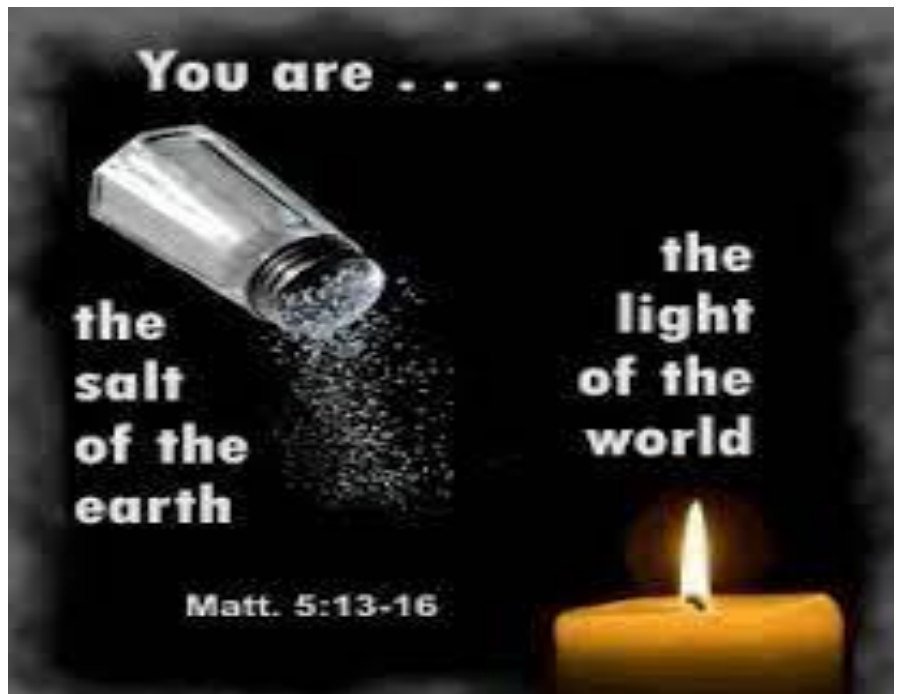
St. Patrick's Day:
