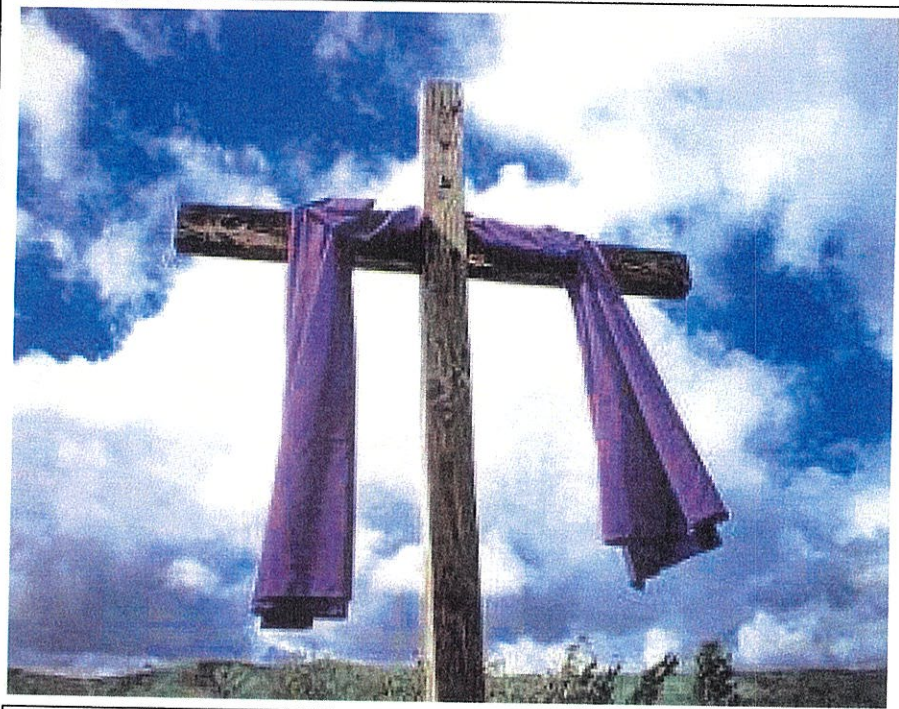

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Today's readings inspire us to remain faithful, in grateful response to a God who loves us so very much. God wants only good for us. He wants to be so closely united to us that we are one with Him. But, only if we allow Him. He will not force His way into our lives. That would not be loving and God is Love itself. We must make Him THE priority of our lives. Putting God first is a grateful response that is very pleasing to Him.

Second Reading: St. Paul's letter to the Romans, gives us good instruction. "Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh...you are in the spirit, if only the Spirit of God dwells in you." To be "in the flesh" means that we allow our own selves – our whims, our pleasure, our comfort-seeking – to determine our daily decisions. To be "in the flesh" is to spend our time, talent, and material gifts primarily on ourselves. Therefore, we leave no room for the Spirit of God to fill our thoughts, our hearts and our souls.

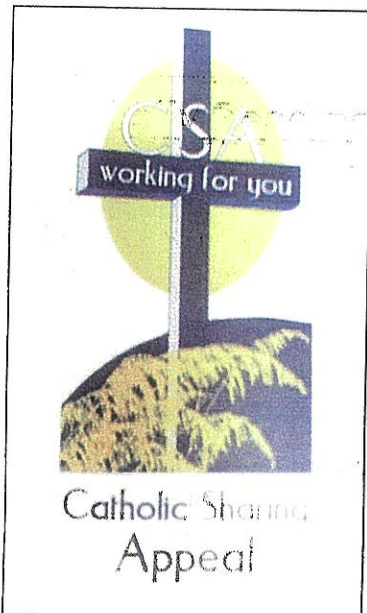
