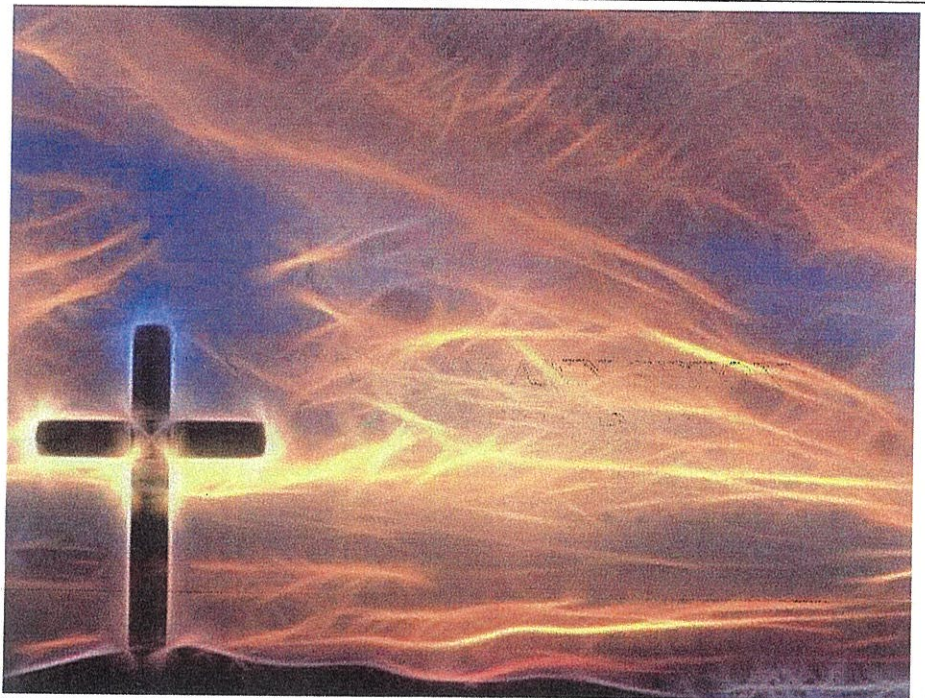

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Abraham (Abram) is instructed by God to leave his home and set out to land that God chose for him. Abram's response is an example of good stewardship. He gives up his comfortable way of life, (recognizing that all he has is a gift from God, puts his trust in God, and obeys. God makes his name great, so that Abram will be a "blessing". A "blessing" is the true aim of a stewardship way of life.

Second Reading: "Bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God." – St. Paul's letter to Timothy. We are weak and inclined towards selfishness and seeking comfort. With God's strength, we can persevere in the fight to attain holiness. Paul reminds us that we were made for this"(God)saved us and called us to a holy life.""Holy" means to be set apart for God. Our lives as Christian stewards will look different from those who do not know the Lord. Let us rely on God's strength to aid us in our spiritual disciplines as we move through Lent to arrive at Easter with deeper holiness.

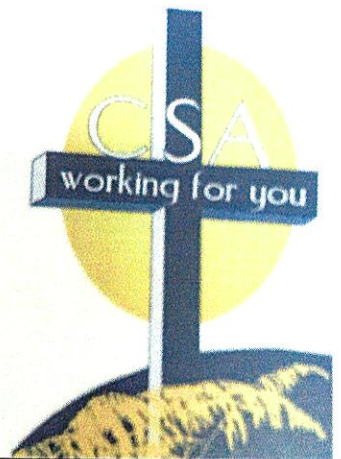
