

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

**First reading:** From the book of Samuel. Recounts God's choice of a king, from among the sons of Jesse. It was the youngest son, the least likely. "Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance but the Lord looks into the heart." God was not impressed with his job title or athletic

achievements. He is pleased by our hearts condition when they are conformed

to Christ and by the way we use our time and gifts to serve others.

<u>Second Reading</u>: From Ephesians reminds us of the aspect of our identity that matters to God and encourages us to live in a way that reflects this. Because of our Baptism, we have the "light" of the Blessed Trinity dwelling within us. It is easy to forget this glorious truth about ourselves. The stewardship way of life, with its emphasis on the rightly ordered use of the gifts of time, talent, and treasure, gives us a guide we can consult on a daily basis to help ensure that we really are living as "children of the light."
