

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocese will take up The Catholic Relief Services Collection on March 18/19. Your support of this collection helps victims of war and natural disasters receive emergency assistance; assists migrants and refugees who need housing, education, and specialized immigration legal assistance; and supports travelers and people whose livelihoods require special pastoral support and access to the sacraments.

Seafarers from around the world sail into the busy ports along the Gulf of Mexico. Fortunately, volunteers from the Stella Maris ministry welcome sailors entering the ports at Point Comfort, Texas, and Mobile, Alabama. Port chaplains celebrate Mass aboard ships, and lay volunteers distribute care packages and Christmas gifts to the sailors, including Bibles, rosaries, and other devotional items.

Stella Maris was founded in 1920 to bring the Church's saving message aboard ships. Over the past century, it has grown into a worldwide ministry to seafarers, port workers, cruise ship passengers, and others associated with the maritime industry. The U.S. national office is a ministry of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Subcommittee on Pastoral Care for Migrants, Refugees and Travelers, which The Catholic Relief Services Collection supports. When you contribute to the collection, you support this special ministry that welcomes and provides for seafarers who are far from home. As one ship captain said of Mobile's Stella Maris ministry, "You not only provide items that all require and have trouble obtaining due to the pandemic, but you remind these guys that someone is thinking about them."

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Nuestra diócesis llevará a cabo The Catholic Relief Services Collection el 18/19 de Marzo. Su apoyo a esta colecta ayuda a las víctimas de guerras y de desastres naturales brindándoles una ayuda de emergencia; presta asistencia a migrantes y refugiados que necesitan vivienda, educación y ayuda legal especializada para asuntos de inmigración; y apoya a viajeros y personas cuyas subsistencias requieren un apoyo pastoral especial y acceso a los sacramentos.

Navegantes de todas partes del mundo con necesidades especiales, tanto materiales come espirituales llegan a los ajetreados puertos ubicados en el Golfo de México. Pero, voluntarios del ministerio Stella Maris recibieron a los navegantes en los puertos de Point Comfort, Texas y de Mobile, Alabama. Los capellanes de los puertos celebran la Misa a bordo de los buques y los voluntarios laicos distribuyen paquetes de ayuda humanitaria y regalos por Navidad a los marineros, incluyendo Biblias, rosarios y otros artículos devocionales.

Stella Maris fue fundada en 1920 para llevar el mensaje salvador de la Iglesia a bordo de los buques. A lo largo del siglo pasado, se ha ido convirtiendo en un ministerio mundial para los navegantes, los trabajadores portuarios, los pasajeros de cruceros y otros asociados con la industria marítima. La oficina nacional en EE.UU. es un ministerio del subcomité para el Cuidado pastoral de migrantes, refugiados y viajeros, de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos, la cual cuenta con el apoyo de The Catholic Relief Services Collection. Cuando ustedes contribuyen a la colecta, están apoyando a este ministerio especial que recibe y ayuda a los navegantes que se encuentran muy lejos de sus hogares. Como lo dijo un capitán al referirse al ministerio de Stella María en Mobile: "Ustedes no solo proporcionan artículos que todos necesitan y que no pueden conseguir a causa de la pandemia, sino que les recuerdan a todos que hay alguien que está pensando en ellos".
