Reflection on Sunday's readings:

<u>First reading:</u> Our focus in today's reading is "sojourning". We have the fullness of the Catholic faith, the power of the sacraments, and the support of our parish family, yet, we lose our way. We lack trust in the perfect goodness and almighty power of God. We lives deal truly in sojourn, with valleys and mountaintops, wrong turns and course corrections regularly. Our Lord opens your eyes to the reality of His presence and truth of His Resurrection.

<u>Second Reading</u>: This reading tells us to "conduct ourselves with reverence during the time of your sojourning, realizing that we were ransomed....with the precious blood of Christ." What a reminder during the Easter season of "why" we embraced the stewardship way of life – we have been ransomed by our Lord's saving death and resurrection. Our Gospel tells of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. They knew Jesus personally. They were believers. Now, what do we do when we become discouraged. We can go to the Scriptures(the living Word of God) and the Eucharist(The very source and summit of our faith). These two gifts are essential to sustain us in our stewardship way of life.


