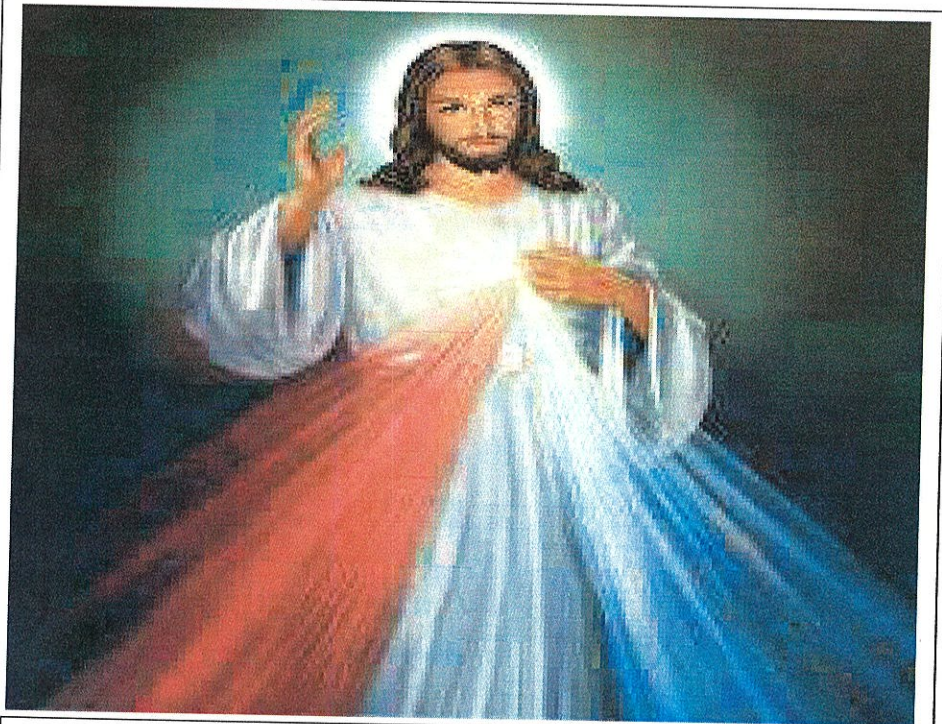

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: First Reading from Acts of the Apostles, we hear what were the results of the faith of the first Christians, (those who came to believe in Jesus immediately following the coming of the Holy Spirit). We need to give thanks to God for the gifts that he has given us.

Second Reading: In the second reading from the First Letter of Saint Paul: The first Christians devoted themselves to the Way of Christ, with four important activities. They would listen to the teachings of the apostles, share their possessions with one another, they would come together to give thanks by breaking bread in memory of Jesus, and they would spend time in prayer. These four activities deepened their relationship with the Risen Jesus and His Father, all in the unity of the Holy Spirit. Faith leads to true community – “being one with”. Faith is not just a personal relationship with Jesus, it is a relationship with others who come together in the name of Jesus.

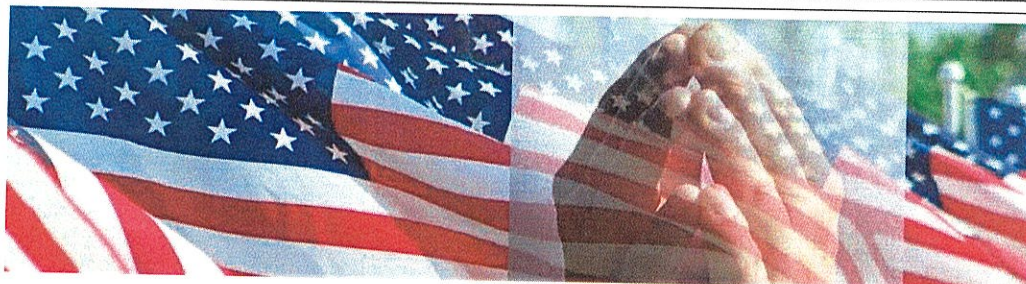
