Reflection on Sunday’s readings:

First reading: In the first reading (Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11) we are told that Jesus appeared to his disciples over a period of forty days after his resurrection and taught them about the kingdom of God. Before he ascended, Jesus told his disciples to stay in Jerusalem and wait for the promised Holy Spirit to come upon them. The disciples at that time, will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes.

Second Reading: The second reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Ephesians speaks of the ascension as an exaltation of Jesus Christ, who is now seated at the right hand of God in heaven, with power and authority over all things, and is a source of hope and enlightenment for believers. We hear that Jesus Christ rules heaven and earth. Jesus tells his disciples to preach the Good News to the whole world. From heaven, Jesus hears our prayers and intercedes for us with his Father.

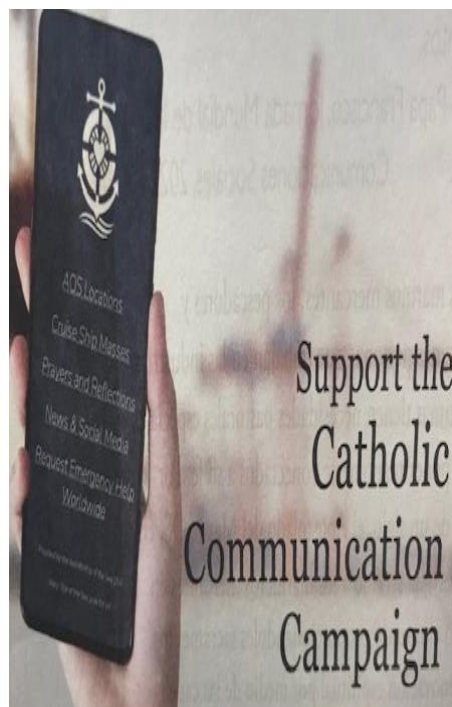
Congratulations to All Graduating Classes of 2023
