Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: In our first reading, we hear of the moments when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the apostles. "Suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house where they were" "Then tongues appeared to them as if of fire-parted and rested on each one of them and all were filled with the Holy Spirit." They began speaking in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim." This personalized way of "gifting" the apostles allowed them to reach different people, sharing with them the "mighty acts of God."

Second Reading: This reading illustrates the beautiful way the Spirit bestows His personal gifts to each of us to use for the good of all. Embracing the stewardship way of life means that we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us in the best use of the unique gifts He has given to each of us. "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." We are called to be Christ's hands and feet to all those He places in our path. Do not let this overwhelm you. Jesus Himself tells us so. He tells us twice in this passage: "Peace be with you."
