Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Moses tells the people that God "let you be afflicted with hunger, and then fed you with manna....in order to show you that not by bread alone does man live, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the Lord. Do not forget the Lord your God." He reminds us thatas we experience physical hunger from lack of food, we become spiritually malnourished through a lack of feeding on the Word of God. God's Word is alive and He intends for us to feed on it daily.

Second Reading:. Our Lord says to the crowds, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is m flesh for the life of the world." In the Old Testament, God fed His people with mana. Now, He feeds us with the very Flesh and Blood of His Son. Just as the Word of God is vital to our spiritual nourishment, so, too is the nourishment of the Eucharist. In the gifts of the Word of God and the Eucharist, we have everything we need to sustain us in this world and guide us to heaven. We must resolve to steward them well with all our hearts.
