

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: St. Paul II described the Holy Trinity as a "Divine Family", Community of Persons Who give themselves completely to each other and shares Itself, Its life, with us. This is the very heart of stewardship way of life. Today, from the Book of Exodus, we read "Having come down in a cloud, the Lord stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, "Lord." He, Himself is "a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." Second Reading: From 2 Corinthians, as St. Paul prays that "the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit" be with us all. We are reminded that this Triune God already is within us through our Baptism. This should motivate us to "mend (our) ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace." We are reminded that the stewardship way of life is nothing more or less than the imitation of our Most Holy Trinity. "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son so everyone who believes might not perish, but have eternal life. "We must love this God back now by giving ourselves, our lives, to Him.
