

## **Reflection on Sunday's readings:**

*First reading:* Our first reading from 2 Kings – shows us how important and necessary the power of hospitality really is. A woman shows her hospitality by inviting a visitor into her home, with her family, to enjoy a meal and she extended her hospitality by arranging a comfortable room for him to stay overnight, while he was traveling. That is the essence of Christian hospitality. This man was the prophet Elisha. He rewarded her kindness by interceding with God to obtain for her the miracle of a baby boy- after years of infertility. **Second Reading**: Letter to the Romans, St. Paul reminds us of the power of Baptism and how this sacrament makes us all disciples. "We must think of ourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus." Nothing less will do. We can only love others, and ourselves truly, if we allow ourselves to be emptied of self-love and filled with God's love. We have come full circle to the importance of hospitality, and to putting God first in our lives because we have become disciples of Christ through our Baptism. We put God first by serving others as if we were serving Christ Himself, thus losing a self-centered life and finding our true fulfillment.


