Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Zechariah tells the unexpected way in which the Lord, the Savior of the world will arrive. He arrived – born as a helpless baby, growing up under the care of human parents and finally making his entrance as savior on lowly colt. Christ has given us a clear and compelling model of humility. We dare not pursue any other path for ourselves if we wish to follow Him. This goes against our nature, where we insist on having our own way, assert our rights at any costs, and put ourselves first to get ahead. How can we live the radical way Christ is calling us to live?

Second Reading: St. Paul tells us "Brothers and sisters: You are not in the flesh; on the contrary, you are in the spirit." Because of our gifts of Baptism and Confirmation, we have -the Holy Spirit- Who gives us every spiritual gift and all the strength we need to follow Christ. St. Paul also reminds us that "For if you live according to the flesh, you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live." Let us resolve to follow in the footsteps of our Savior, embracing the humble path of stewardship. It is the path that leads to peace here and now, and ultimately leads us to heaven.
