Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Today's readings are filled with analogies for the stewardship of life, demonstrating the slow and steady effect this lifestyle will have on those who embrace it. The analogy in the first reading is using the Word as "rain and snow" that water the earth-making it fertile and fruitful, giving seed to the one who sows and bread to the one who eats. "His Word always serves a purpose. It gives us life, sustains our very being. We must commit to regular prayer time with God's Word, then we can count on it to take root in us and transform our lives.

Second Reading: Jesus explains that "seeds" are all those "who hear the word of the kingdom. The Word is meant for everyone, as the sower scatters it far and wide.
