#### Reflection on Sunday's readings:

**First reading:** This first reading tells us how Solomon requested the gift of understanding instead of material goods or power. The psalm reminds us that God's commands are more precious than gold. This highlights the huge value of the Kingdom of Heaven, comparing it to a treasure hidden in a field and a pearl of great value. This shows us the worthiness of sacrificing everything to possess and experience the Kingdom's blessings. We must be willing to sacrifice worldly possessions in order to obtain the Kingdom's eternal riches. When God offered to grant Solomon a wish, and he asks for an understanding heart to distinguish right from wrong. God granted Solomon unrivaled wisdom. **Second Reading:** In this reading, we are to work for God's purpose. Jesus gives us parables related to the Kingdom of God, including the treasure in the field, the pearl of great value, and treasures new and old. Jesus urges his disciples to become like scribes trained for the kingdom, emphasizing the need for attentive listening, understanding and applying the Kingdom principles in their lives.
