

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: When we take our eyes off God, we fail to see that all is gift from Him, we lose trust in Him and we do not make our lives a grateful response to Him. When we embrace the stewardship way of life, letting go of a tight hold over our money, time, and talents, our lives become a grand adventure, rooted firmly and gratefully in the God Who always cares for us.

<u>Second Reading</u>: In the Second Reading Paul remarks that his fellow Israelites, God's chosen people who have received so many gifts from God-the law, the promises, the patriarchs-fail to see the gift of Christ now offered to them. This is happening today-We received all the riches of Church teaching and the Scriptures, and the overwhelming treasury of graces in the sacraments, including the gift of Christ Himself in the Eucharist. Our families, our friends, our work, our parish—all these things are gifts from God as well. Once we take our eyes off God, we fail to see that all is a gift from Him, we lose trust in Him and we do not make our lives a grateful response to Him. We must not take our eyes off Christ, the many blessings He has given us and the loving way He treats us.


Today is the Diocesan Second Collection-Churches in Latin America.


