



Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: God wants to lead us to the joy of heaven to spend eternity with Him. We must be strong in faith and live our lives as an act of love and gratitude to Him. We must allow Him to transform us into saints. Sometimes, we will feel pain but, often it will be challenging. We must remember that even though it seems that God is not answering our prayers, we must trust in Him. God is ever-faithful, even when we are not. We need to remember-Our parish is not a country club. It is meant for all and must be a welcome place for allwhere we roll up our sleeves together to serve and worship our God. God knows we will choose selfishness and stay in our comfort zones, rather than answering the call to discipleship, but God will never withhold His love and His gifts from us.

Second Reading: God is patient and merciful with us when we falter in the stewardship way of life. God is indeed merciful and faithful. He wants to lead us to the joy of heaven to spend eternity with Him. We must therefor remain strong in faith and live our lives as an act of love and gratitude to Him. We must let go of our tight hold over our money, time, and talents, our lives become a grand adventure, rooted firmly and gratefully in the God Who cares.
