

### Reflection on Sunday's readings:

**First reading:** Our readings today challenge us to look at the truth about ourselves. The gifts and blessings that God has given us-our time, talents, and material possessions – are meant to be used in a manner that says" Christ is my Savior and I am His disciple." The most eloquent praise we can offer Him is a life lived in grateful response to His unfathomable love. This is the beauty and power of a stewardship way of life.

<u>Second Reading</u>: Jesus is getting personal with us today. He poses that same question to every one of us who call ourselves His stewards and modern day disciples. Surely, we would answer as Peter did, that Jesus is the Christ, Son of the living God. The question remains, - Does your life reflect that answer? ### **EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL**


