

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

<u>First reading:</u> Our First Reading is taken from the Book of Daniel. (Daniel is considered one of the major prophets). Most interesting, in this reading is that it refers to the "Son of Man" which is the term Jesus Himself used most often to describe Himself. The "Son of Man" occurs 85 times in the Gospels, and in 83 of them it is Jesus who uses the term. (32 times in Matthew, 15 times in Mark, 26 times in Luke and 12 times in John. In John, it is used twice by someone other than Jesus.)

<u>Second Reading</u>: The Transfiguration was not a different miracle; it was part of an ongoing miracle. The real miracle was perhaps that Jesus kept away from displaying His glory most of the time. Knowing God, appreciating God, and embracing God should give us confidence. God's grace is amazing, and that needs to be our reality. Remember, Jesus is on His way to crucifixion and temporary death. We are on that same path, but the Transfiguration is a reminder to us of the hope we have in the saving grace of the Lord.



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon our diocese will take up the Collection for the Church in Latin America. For more than 50 years, this collection has been a way for Catholics in the United States to unite more closely with our brothers and sisters in faith throughout Latin America and the Caribbean through supporting diocesan pastoral catechetical and family life ministries, seminary studies, and formation programs for religious sisters and brothers. The collection even helps the poorest dioceses obtain basic necessities that they otherwise would be unable to afford, which would leave them unable to minister effectively to the faithful.

At the far eastern end of the island of Cuba, the priests in the Diocese of Guantánamo-Baracoa traverse bad roads over rough terrain to bring the sacraments and the Word of God to the faithful living there. The mountainous territory that makes up 75% of the diocese's total land area makes travel not only difficult but also more expensive for priests due to higher fuel consumption, vehicle maintenance, and repair costs compared to other regions.

Catholics like you who generously contribute to the Collection for the Church in Latin America help Guantánamo-Baracoa's priests stay on the road with funds given to the diocese to offset fuel and vehicle repair costs. In places such as Cuba, you help bring the Good News to the poor when you participate in the collection.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Pronto, nuestra diócesis realizará la Colecta para la Iglesia en América Latina. Por más de 50 años, esta colecta les ha brindado a los católicos en los Estados Unidos una forma de unirse más estrechamente con nuestros hermanos y hermanas en la fe en toda América Latina y el Caribe, brindando su apoyo a los ministerios diocesanos para la pastoral catequética y para la vida familiar, a estudios en los seminarios y a programas de formación para hermanas y hermanos religiosos. La colecta ayuda incluso a las diócesis más pobres para que puedan hacer frente a sus necesidades básicas que, de otra manera, no les fuese posible cumplir y que no les permitiria brindar una pastoral eficaz a sus fieles.

En el extremo oriental de la isla de Cuba, los sacerdotes en la Diócesis de Guantánamo-Baracoa deben recorrer unos caminos muy malos sobre terrenos accidentados a fin de llevar los sacramentos y la Palabra de Dios a los fieles que residen allí. En comparación con otras regiones, ese territorio montañoso, que cubre un 75% del área total del terreno, no solo les presenta obstáculos a los sacerdotes para poder movilizarse, sino que también les resulta más caro por la mayor cantidad de combustible, por el mantenimiento del vehículo y por el costo de las reparaciones.

Los católicos como ustedes, quienes contribuyen generosamente a la Colecta para la Iglesia en América Latina, ayudan a los sacerdotes de Guantánamo-Baracoa para que puedan continuar movilizándose con los fondos entregados a la diócesis para compensar el costo del combustible y de las reparaciones del vehículo. Cuando ustedes participan en esta colecta, están ayudando a llevar la Buena Nueva a los pobres en lugares tal como Cuba.
