### MASS INTENTIONS

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Our Families, neighbors, friends and parish family need us, and we need them to be our best selves. Our first reading shows us how we can become good stewards, beginning with the reading from the prophet Ezekiel. God tells Ezekiel that he has appointed him "watchman" Because of our Baptism, each of us is a "watchman" for one another.

Second Reading: St. Paul in the second reading to guide us when we deal with others. "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" This is what Christ taught. Love is the overall principal that guides us to be good stewards f our relationships and communities. Sometimes true love means seeking the good of another. If you take your frustrations out on someone who has offended us, on social media---this is not love. Jesus wants us to confront the offending person directly-with the goal of restoring the relationship. This is how we steward our relationships even through rocky waters. We have been given the gift of our Catholic faith and we have a responsibility to lovingly and generously share that gift. As Christian stewards, we must take this call to heart every day of the week and in every setting in which we find ourselves.






