

Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Our first reading, from Sirach, brings to light the emotion of anger. How can we feed anger toward another, and expect the Lord to heal our hearts? Each one of us has experienced anger to one or another- but, we must remember that our emotions are gifts from God. We can not allow anger to take over our lives. Sirach tells us that we must "Remember your last days, set enmity aside—Remember the Most High's covenant and overlook faults." We are to embrace the stewardship mindset and not brood over hurts.

Second Reading: We must remember, we live for God and not ourselves. The Lord loves us completely and we can rest in this truth. We do not need to hold onto anger over injustices. St. Paul says it this way in our second reading from Romans:"For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord, so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's". This is why we must look inward to the state of our hearts-the deepest part of us—our thoughts and emotions.
