Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: Today's Readings are about Love. From the beginning, God reveals Himself as a loving and compassionate Father, Who has a particular concern for the most vulnerable of His people. He wants us to have that same compassion from his people in our treatment of one another. This is the radical God that we serve.

Second Reading: Both Commandments have the same thing in common. It is: LOVE. Love God first and love neighbor as self. Do you think God might be calling you to love Him with your whole heart, soul and mind by committing to a daily time of praying with the Scriptures? He might be calling you to spend time with Him in adoration or a weekday Mass, or asking you to put Him first as a family with a time for evening or morning prayer, together. He may want you to spend less time watching the news or surfing the internet and more time thinking of all the blessings He has given you each day. Love your neighbor as yourself main mean checking on a neighbor who is isolated, listening to them, or getting involved in a ministry that serves children or the poor. The stewardship way of life is the unique way that each of us applies the two greatest commandments to our daily lives. It is all about: LOVE.

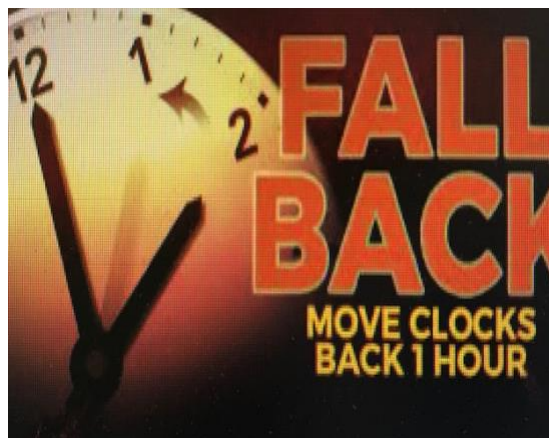


