# Reflection on Sunday's readings:

**First reading:** Advent: This is the time where we to prepare for the coming of the lord. In our first reading, we are asking the Lord to return to us and save us. We must remember that our lives are not about us, our wants and wishes, but rather they are a gift to be used to glorify God and serve others. During this Advent we should commit to a daily Gospel reflection, visit a lonely neighbor, or donate money to those in dire need. Do not waste any more time.

<u>Second Reading</u>: In this reading, we are reminded of the gifts that God has bestowed upon us. During this time, we are to recommit to stewarding our spiritual gifts, as well. As St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians reminds us: "You were enriched in every way, with all discourse and knowledge, so that you are not lacking in any spiritual gift as you wait for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ." Look and re-evaluate your life, what are your priorities? Do you want to be ready for our Lord's second coming? Be watchful! Be Alert! You do not know when the time will come.


