Reflection on Sunday's readings:

First reading: The First Reading, from Ezekiel tells us the Lord is a like a tender shepherd who knows His flock intimately and seeks to heal and save us. This love is impossible to fully understand. We should marvel at the greatness of our God and resolve to thank Him by giving Him the very best of our time, our talents, our treasure—and to imitating His love as best we can.

Second Reading: The Second Reading shows us that He is humble. Jesus Christ is King of all, having authority over all, both individual people and nations, both material world and the spiritual world. As we are called to love our King, still we must respect and revere His authority over us. We must remember everything we have, every breath we take, is a gift from this King. In justice, we must give Him His due. The more committed we are to the stewardship way of life, the more closely our priorities will align with His. This will prepare us well for our judgment day and help us to live in imitation of our King right now.

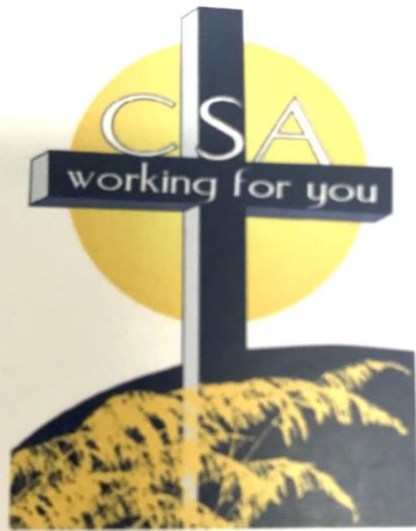
