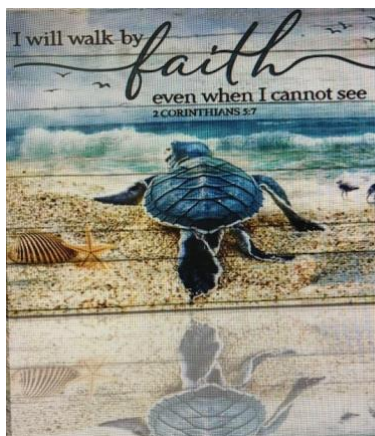

**Post script:** We all suffer spiritually, emotionally, psychologically, relationally, physically and morally. I discovered a beautiful prayer in one of my mother’s spiritual books after my father died. I share it with you now. It’s called “The Sufferer’s Prayer.” The Holy Spirit led me to pray it daily, close to 35 years now, for all who suffer so that not one droplet of suffering will be lost, carried in vain, nor for vainglory...but for God and God alone.
