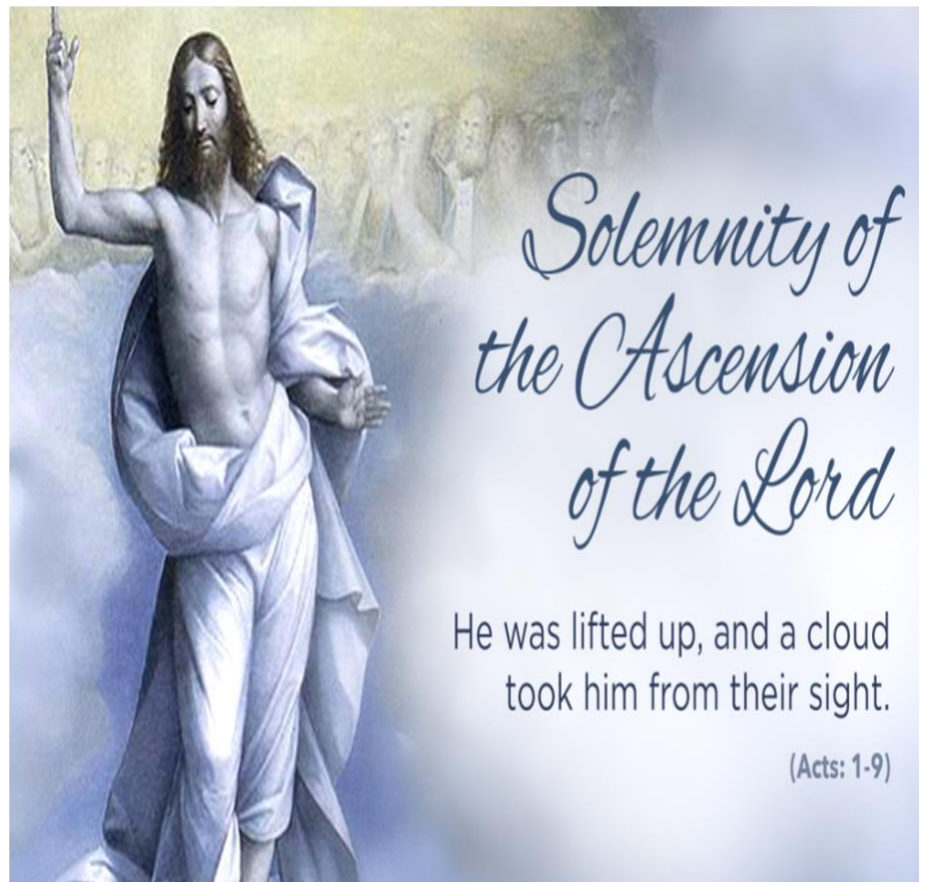

Lord of the Rings

When God takes something from your grasp, He's not punishing you but merely opening your hands to receive something better. "The will of God will never take you where the grace of God will not protect you."

Long ago a friend once told me not to look at my life as separate incidences but to see how God was weaving the threads of life mysteriously into a beautiful tapestry. All I could see were lose threads and tangled strings. A couple of years ago, Jesus revealed a deeper love and called me to be His own. The rings I wear have a story of their own to tell, but that's for another day. He is Lord of the rings..."not the one ring that controls them all"...but the Lord of love that rings round me all the days of my life.

Longsuffering is one of the fruits of the Holy Spirit. It is not for the faint of heart. It isn't one I would have gone and sought out on my own. But I have learned there can be no fruit on a branch or vine unless the seed is sown first. When pondering the events of my life as one continuous movement of God's shuttle..mysterious colors appear as a baby in leg braces, a quadriplegic mother from MS, a motherless child at 14, a broken back and a brace, a miscarriage, a broken neck and halo brace, the task to walk again, the traumatic pregnancy of my first born son, who becomes a priest; my 2nd son, who becomes a soldier working with bombs, has been in two very dangerous bombing incidences and another eventful day when we did not know for 12 hours if he was alive or dead, each of these happened during his three tours in Afghanistan and is miraculously alive; my 3rd son's open heart surgery, and then the ushering in of widowhood with the death of my spouse. God showed he strengthened my legs, healed my broken back and broken neck to stand straight and tall spiritually and physically, never to be shamed faced again as He left his visible fingerprints on my forehead and the back of my head. Twice have I been a hairs breath from dying, once in 1981 and again this past summer of 2023 from a tiny bacteria that had been attacking my body and my heart which I am still recovering from. He has healed the deepest wounds my sins have caused and restored the gift of salvation He won for me. Jesus said,"many are called but few are chosen." I am awed He called and chose.and I.."I am the handmaid of the Lord let it be done to me according to your word." And He showed me how.

There are two Christian songs by Fernando Ortega, a Christian artist that bring to close my testimony. You can look them up on YouTube. First one is: I stretched Out My Hands (Ode37) and the second is: Come Down O Love Divine.

Post script: We all suffer spiritually, emotionally, psychologically, relationally, physically and morally. I discovered a beautiful prayer in one of my mother's spiritual books after my father died. I share it with you now. It's called "The Sufferer's Prayer." The Holy Spirit led me to pray it daily, close to 35 years now, for all who suffer so that not one droplet of suffering will be lost, carried in vain, nor for vainglory...but for God and God alone.

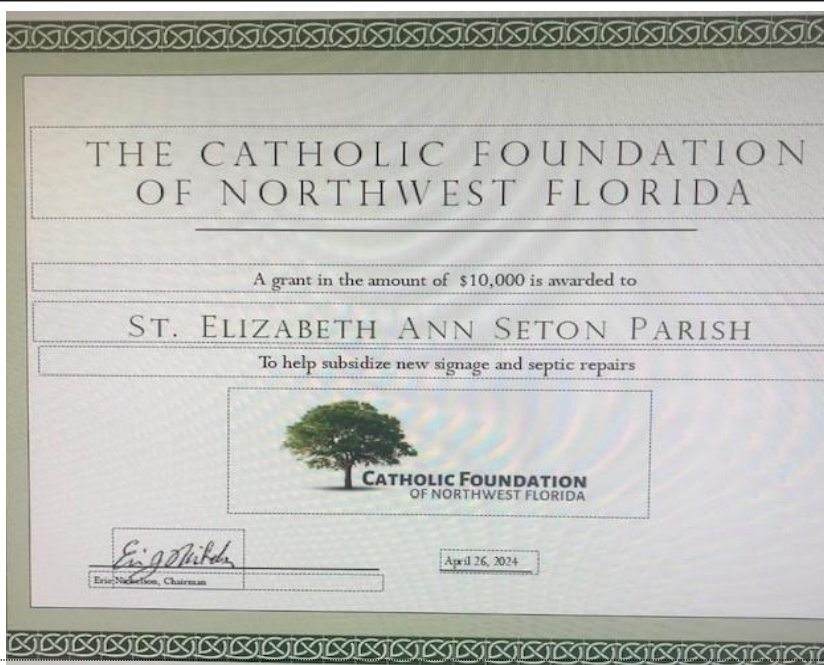
