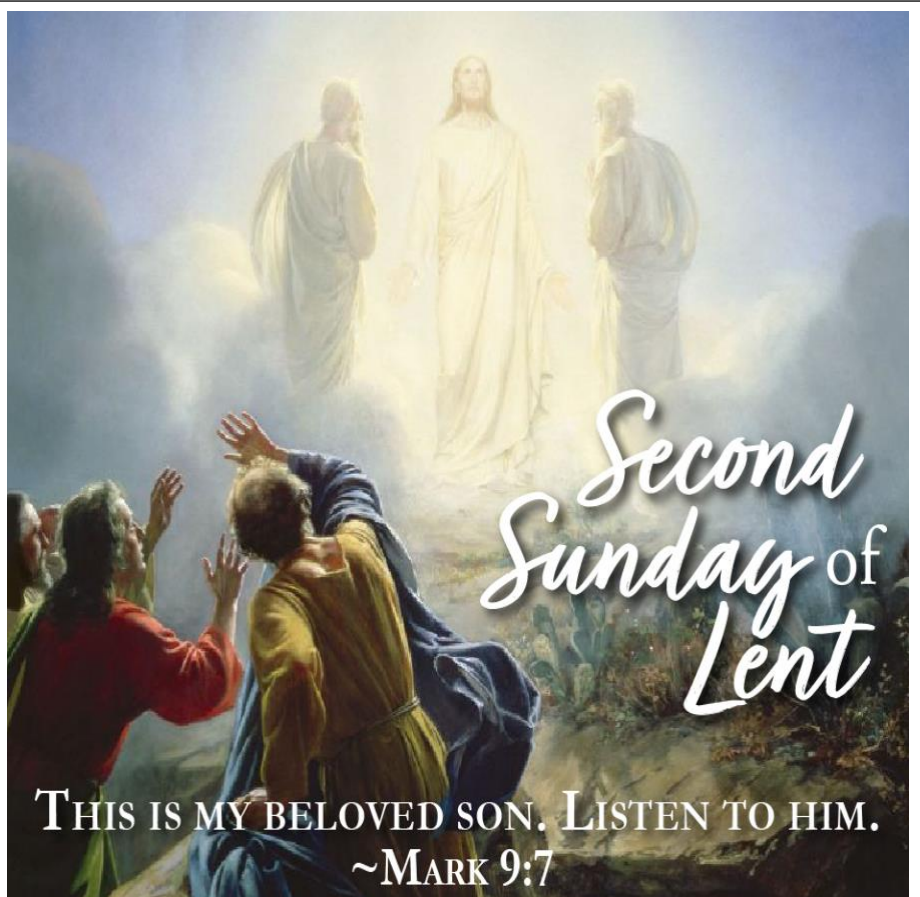

 Steamed/Roasted Carrots 4 Foil Pans-Each pan 5.5lbs.
 Steamed/Roasted Green Beans 4 Foil Pans-Each pan 4lbs.
 Steamed/Roasted Asparagus 4 Foil Pans- Each pan 6lbs.
 Steamed/Roasted Sweet Potatoes 4 Foil Pans-Each pan 6lbs.
 Seasoned Rice 2 Foil Pans-Each pan 3 cups uncooked rice


