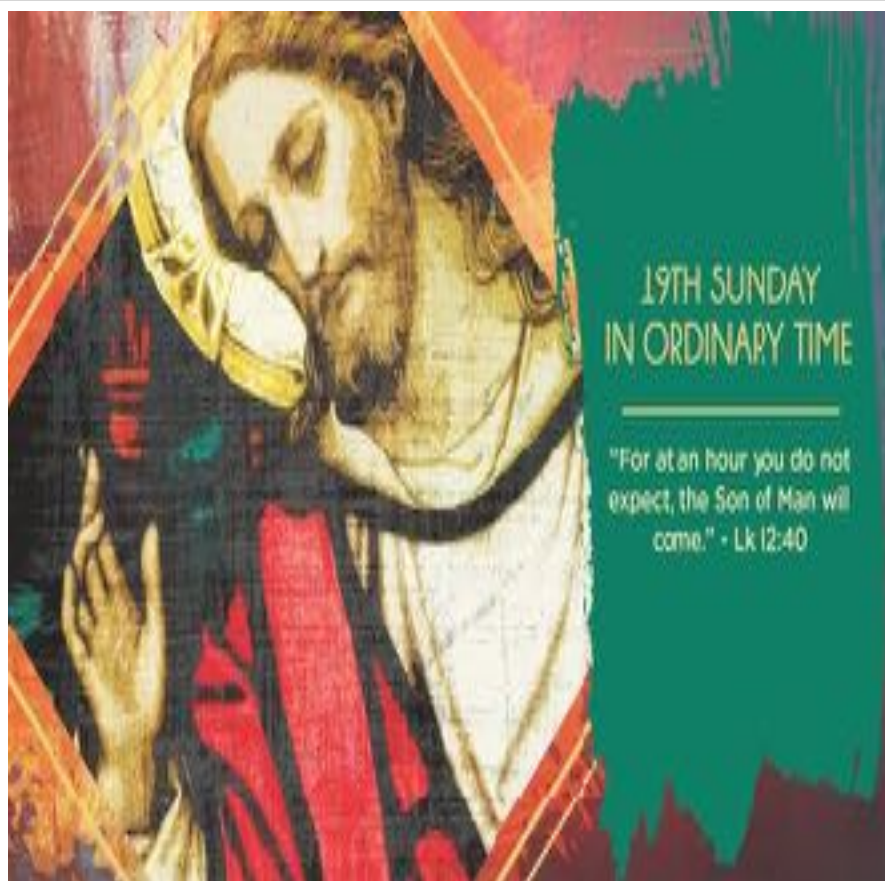



All young men and young ladies-we need altar servers....Please see Father Hartley or Deacon Dave after mass.

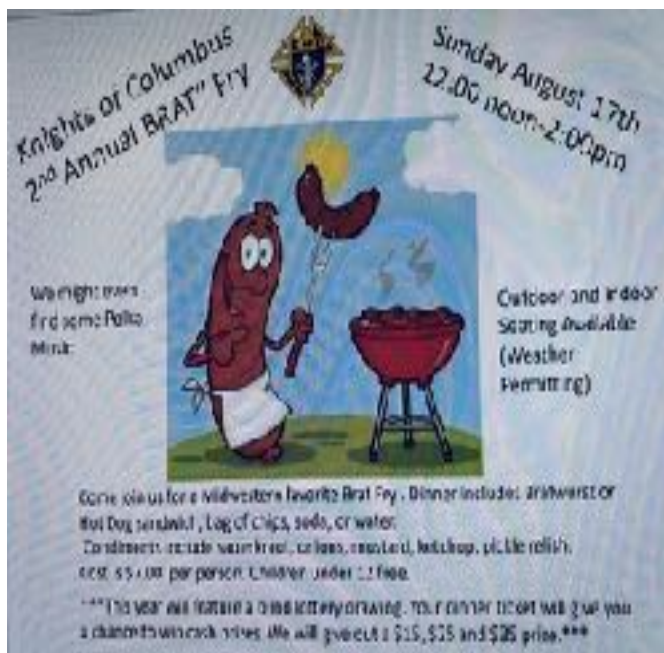
Praying for Our Men and Women in the Service
