Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

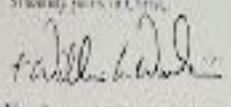

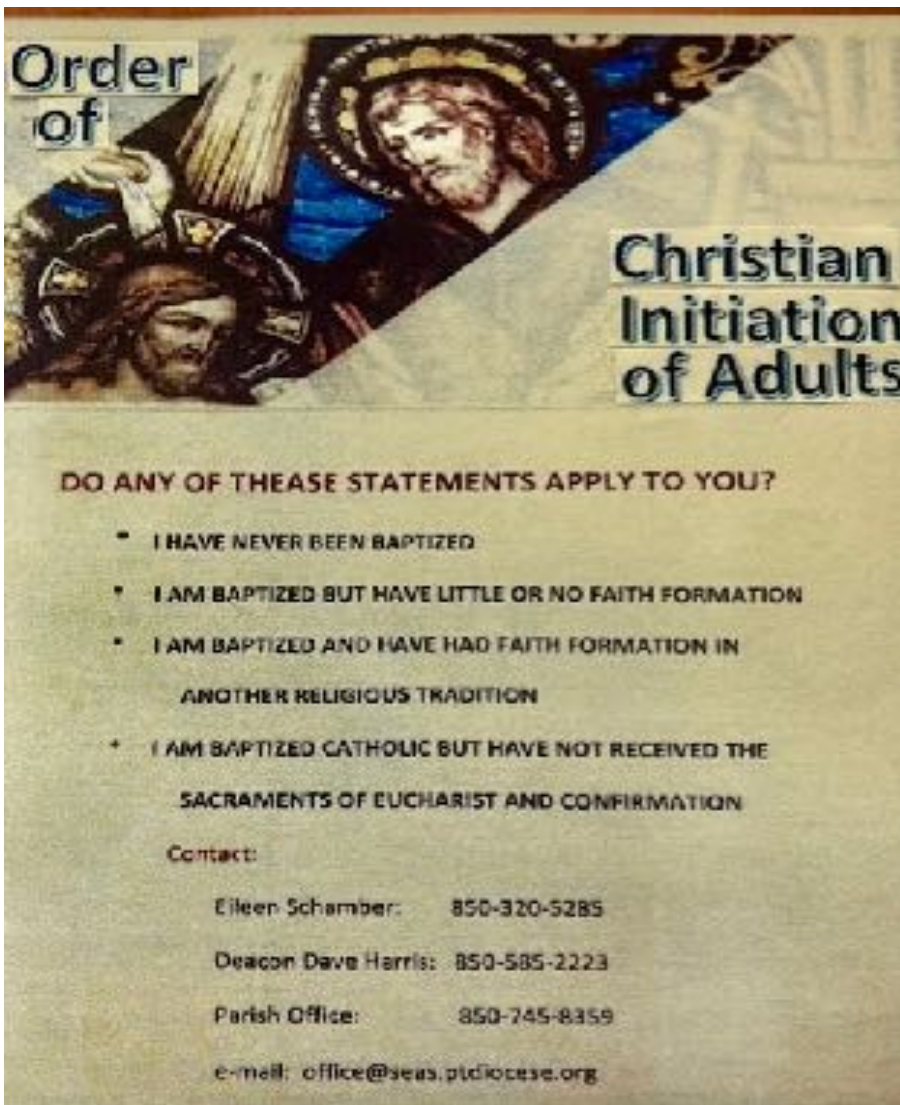

Ladies Circle's is meeting on Oct. 19th, after the Sunday mass in the Social Hall. All members are asked to attend.

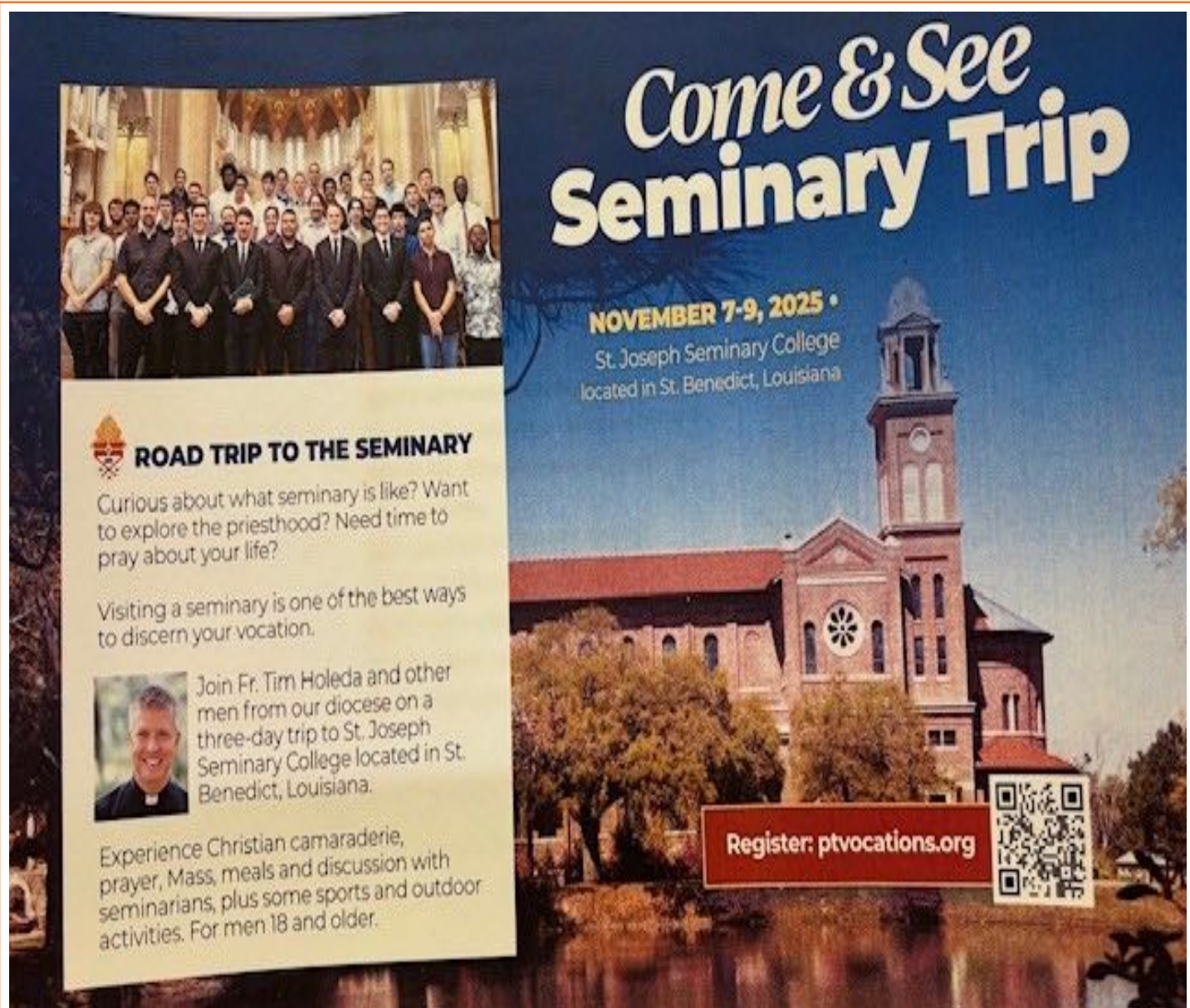
