
Information on Marriages and Annulment

VIRTUS: Anyone wishing to volunteer to do ANY type of work on or around the church property is required due to liability issues, to complete the VIRTUS Training and Background Check- Including fingerprinting. This is mandatory from the Diocese. VIRTUS registrations are available in the office. The registration will allow you to complete all training modules on-line that you are required to have for your specific job. You will be required to schedule an appointment on-line for having fingerprints taken.
