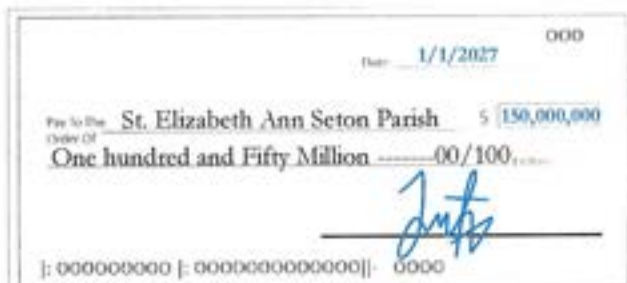
The group meets every Sunday before Mass at 9am.

PRISON MINISTRY

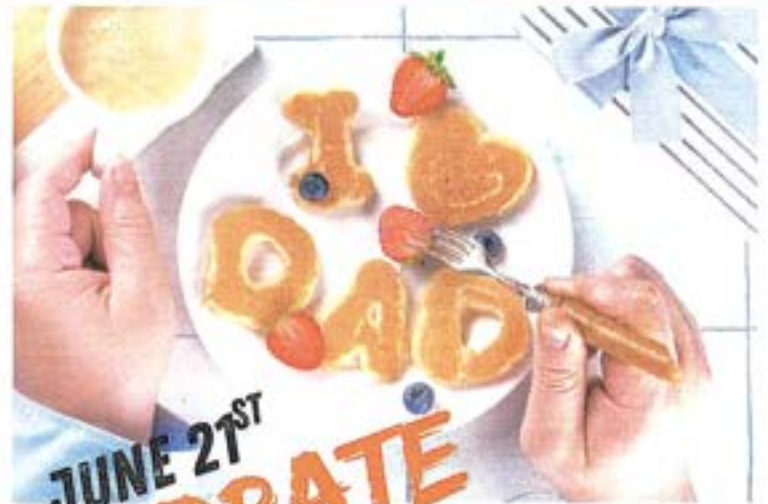

Currently, only one volunteer from Sacred Heart in Lanark has been able to join the team. We would love to see 4 or 5 more at least, but all are welcome to participate.

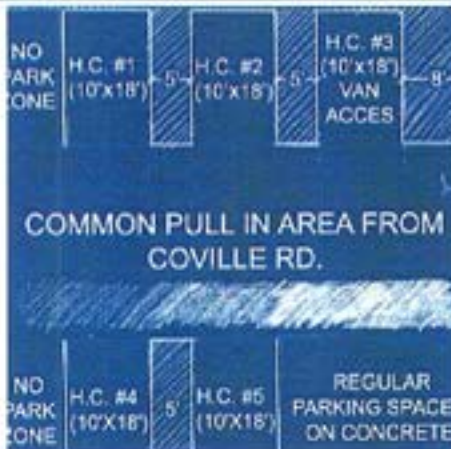

DRIVEWAY AND PARKING LOT PAVING



As part of our new driveway and parking improvements, our existing handicap parking area must be updated to meet current state (FDOT) and federal (ADA) accessibility standards.

Whenever a parking area is resurfaced or restriped, there is a legal requirement to bring it into compliance with modern accessibility guidelines. These standards ensure that parking spaces are properly sized, clearly marked, and located in a way that allows safe and convenient access for those with mobility challenges.

In Florida, these requirements are especially specific, including proper striping, clearly marked access aisles, and visible blue markings to designate accessible spaces.

Updating our parking area is not only a matter of compliance—it is also an important step in serving all our parishioners with dignity, safety, and care.

We appreciate your patience as we complete these improvements.
