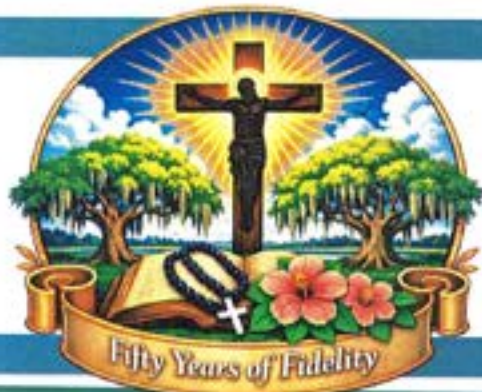

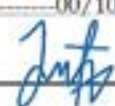
The group meets every Sunday before Mass at 9am.

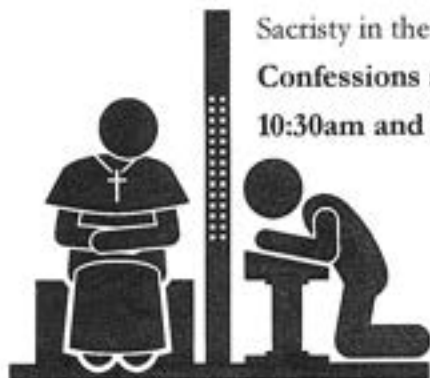

The Confessional will be relocating to the former Sacristy in the Church Vestibule very soon.

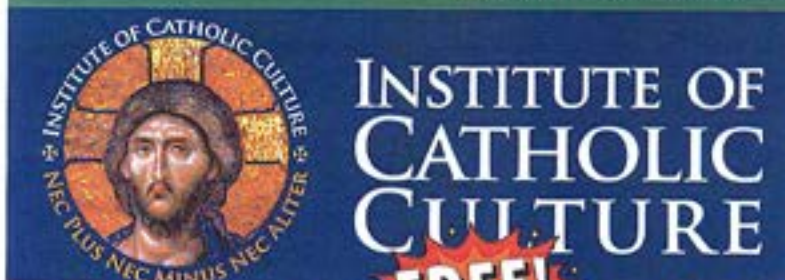
Confessions are held every Saturday from 9:30-10:30am and just before Vigil Mass at 4:30pm
