PAVING OUR DRIVEWAY AND PARKING AREAS



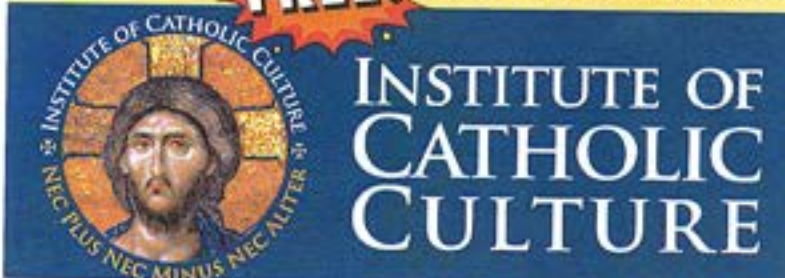
